

COMMUNIQUÉ

With regard to the activity of the commission from the Prevention and Investigation of Corruption and Fraud Directorate within the Ministry of National Defense at „Carol I” National Defense University:

- The undergoing checks envisage the way in which academic titles such as lecturer, reader and professor are awarded and do not have in view in any way the organization of doctoral studies;

- All contests for didactic positions were organized and held in accordance with the requirements of the Law no. 128/1997 on the status of didactic personnel, the orders of the minister of education and university internal regulations. The academic positions for which contests were organized and held were published in the Official Monitor and in the Military Observer, with the approval of the Human Resources Management Directorate within the Ministry of National Defense. The results of the contests were validated by the university Senate, and the academic titles of reader and professor were awarded by order of the minister of education;

- We also wish to state that within „Carol I” National Defense University there were no violations of any existing legal requirements with regard to public acquisitions or the obtaining of undeserved material advantages as a result of didactic activities, and the premises for such violations do not exist.

With the purpose of accurately informing the public opinion, we will make public the conclusions reached by the checking commission as soon as they become available to us.

The leadership of the „Carol I” National Defense University cooperates in an open and transparent manner with the checking commission in order to clarify all aspects under investigation.
