

“Carol I” National Defence University and the American Romanian Academy of Arts and Sciences with the support of the Ministry of Education, Research, Youth and Sport organize the 34<sup>th</sup> “Scientific Research – Security – Durable Development” Congress on 29 – 23 May 2010.
